The main objective of the conference is to bring together policy-makers, researchers, and academics to integrate space into policy and decision-making, raise awareness about the activities of various entities involved in space, including international and national agencies, industry,

and civil society, and highlight capacity-building efforts and international cooperation and partnerships involving emerging nations and industries. Experts, government officials, and academics from around the world are invited to come together to discuss ways to efficiently use space technology to contribute to socioeconomic development in various ways. Satellite-based communication systems can provide internet access and connectivity to remote and underserved areas, enabling people in these regions to access information and communication technologies and participate in the global economy.
